

CONGRATULATIONS

You have purchased our Vinny Reverb 5 watt combo guitar amplifier. The Vinny Reverb unit is a compact but quite large sounding tube amp with a tone control, spring reverb, and unique tube driven power scaling (not a silicon MOSFET).

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

No user servicable parts inside...do not open or service unless you are a qualified technician. High voltages present even when powered off.

Do not service while plugged in.

Do not expose to water.

Do not operate at an incorrect line voltage.

Never operate amplifier without a speaker load

CONTROLS

Volume, Tone, Reverb, Power

The unique power scaling in the Vinny Reverb is driven by the 6V6 power tube, which effectively lends an element of sag and musicality to the tone, as opposed to the traditional solid state circuits that utilize a MOSFET. That being said, things can get weird with the power all the way down...be prepared to adjust the volume tone and reverb settings to compensate for reduced headroom in the power stages.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

Plug your instrument straight into the input of your amp. If the problems continue...

Try multiple instrument cables between your instrument and the amp.

Try a different instrument, or plug your instrument into a different listening source / amp to ensure the instrument itself isn't having issues.

If you have access to multiple speaker cabinets, try plugging your amp into a different speaker cabinet.

If none of these illuminate the problem, replace the tubes (only if you are comfortable doing so), and if that doesn't fix, bring the Vinny Reverb in for service, either at Benson Amps or a qualified service center.

CARE

If you must clean, do so gently with a dry cloth.

Power tubes should be changed approximately once a year with regular use, and preamp tubes should be changed approximately every two years with that same usage.

WARRANTY

Our warranty is two years from purchase excluding tubes/abuse. We will repair any unit outside of warranty, often for a nominal fee. For service or information, go to www.bensonamps.com.
